Practical Theology - We react to Practical Steps

A draft timeline would be helpful. Evan will explore and "bring" a draft to our next call. The term "Moments of Decision" was used.

Invite people to talk about what they are already doing.

What is the language of Stewardship?

"People come to Church to find a better god than money."

Trellis is needed to produce "fruit" like a Rule of Life.

Translate words to use as a resource across the church.

List ten traditions around money – personal audit.

Suggest approaches to help other take this seriously...not prescriptive but descriptive.

After some discussion, it was decided to create one Google doc on which individuals would share their own reflections on the theology of money, including scriptural, liturgical, and other running list of theological resources that have been important to them. Everyone was asked to post by 5/14, giving 2 weeks to write and everyone 2 weeks to read each other's reflections.

Suggested Next Steps:

Offer our list on certain subjects however be prepared to be criticized as others contribute.

Over the next week or 2, those who contributed thoughts during the "meeting" are invited to summarize their high points – especially if not above or nor as thorough above as might be helpful. In other words, share our reflections so all can read.
