Discussion about the Anglican / Episcopal churches as rooted in colonial practice. What does it mean when the church doesn't look like the community around us? How can we call our church to exercise a theology of social justice inside the church? Examples: when an Hispanic priest is told he can't serve "over" non-Hispanics, what is that saying? Or when a community wants to invest its resources into serving the community, feeding, sheltering etc., instead of a full-time priest but rather a bivocational priest, is that church looked down upon or held up?
