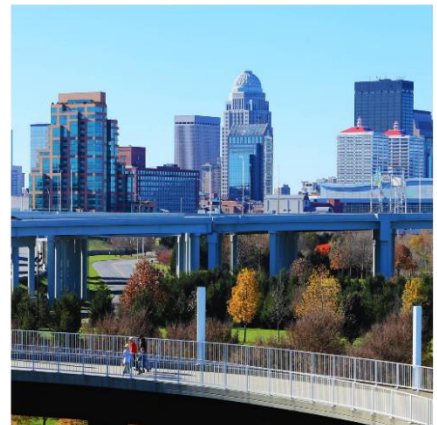

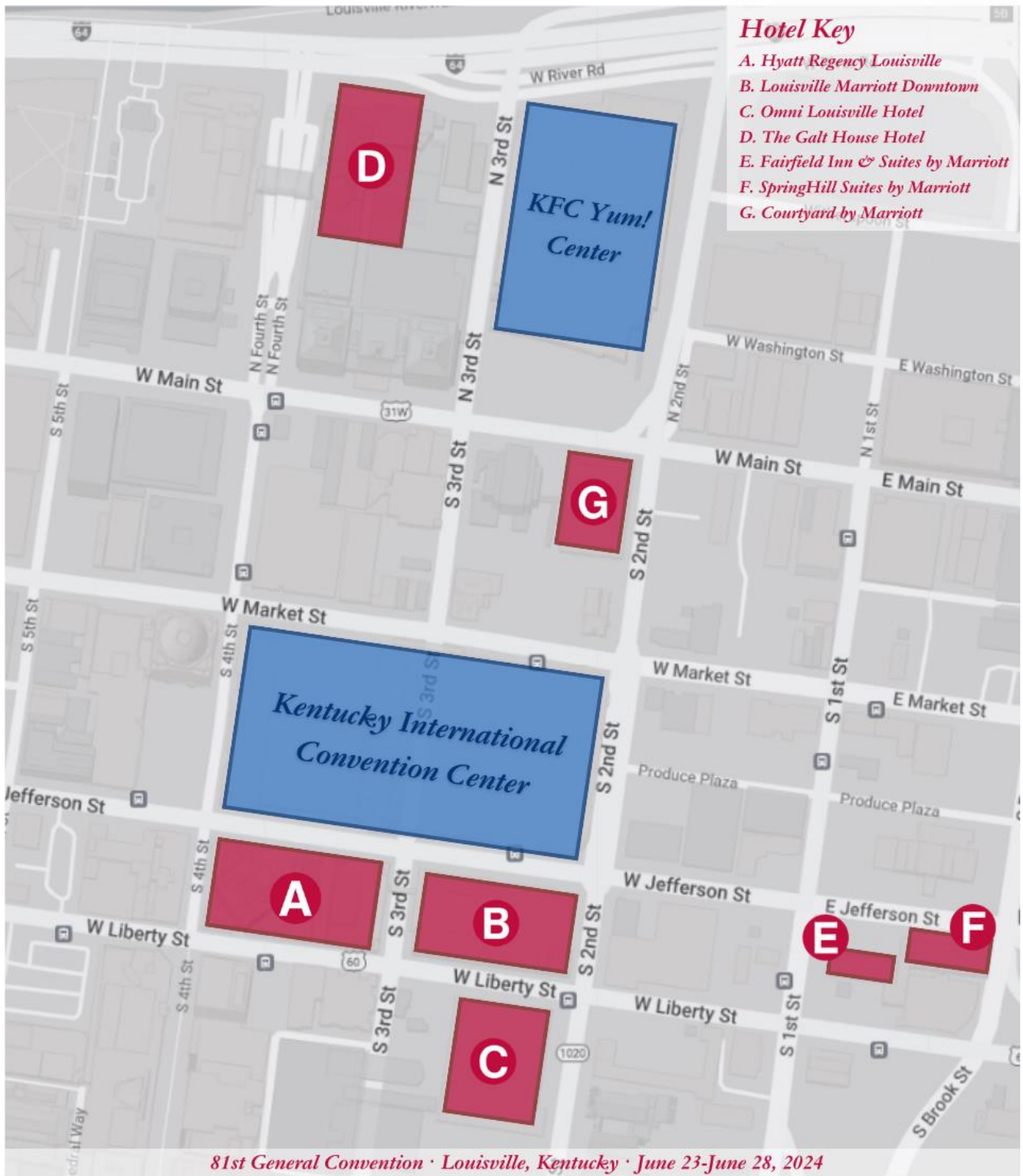

A. Hyatt Regency Louisville | 320 W Jefferson Street

Standard Rate \$169 per night, single or double occupancy (\$196.16 with tax)
