Once you click on the Virtual Binder link above you will be prompted to select a house and a language. These selections will be remembered each time you open the Virtual Binder, and you can also switch houses or languages by tapping the buttons in the upper right corner of the screen at anytime.

Then you will be brought to the home screen where there are a variety of options to choose from. For the purposes of finding details on the final actions of General Convention, the button you want to click is the Resolutions one. There you can see all the resolutions that have been filed. You can search by proposer, committee, keyword, or simply by the resolution number.
